Course: STA257H1F, Probability and Statistics I

Course Description: This course covers probability including its role in statistical modeling. Topics include probability distributions, expectation, continuous and discrete random variables and vectors, distribution functions. Basic limiting results and the normal distribution presented with a view to their applications in statistics.

Exclusion: ECO227Y1/STA255H1/STA247H1

Prerequisite: MAT135Y1/137y1/157Y1(MAT137Y1/157Y1 is strongly recommended)

Co-requisite: MAT235Y1/237Y1/257Y1(MAT235Y1/257Y1 is strongly recommended)

Estimated Enrolment: 60

Estimated Teaching Assistant Support: Approx. 100 hours, depending on enrolment

Class schedule: Wednesdays from 7:00 – 10:00 p.m.

Sessional Dates: September 1, 2008 – December 31, 2008 (Includes the completion of any course work or marking not finished by December 31, 2008)

Salary: \$6,500 for Sessional Lecturer I; \$7,000 for Sessional Lecturer II

Qualifications: Master's or PhD degree in Statistics or related discipline; good communication skills; prior experience as a Teaching Assistant in this course is an asset.

Duties: Teaching; setting and invigilating term tests and final examinations; reporting final grades; counseling students; supervising teaching assistant(s).
