**Course:** STA261H1S, Probability and Statistics II

**Course Description:** A sequel to STA257H1 giving an introduction to current statistical theory and methods. Topics include: estimation, testing, and confidence intervals; unbiasedness, sufficiency, likelihood; simple linear and generalized linear models.

*Exclusion:* ECO227Y1/STA248H1/STA255H1

*Prerequisite:* STA257H

**Estimated Teaching Assistant Support:** Approx. 50 hours, depending on enrolment

**Class schedule:** Wednesdays from 7:00 – 10:00 p.m.

**Salary:** \$6,500 for Sessional Lecturer I; \$7,000 for Sessional Lecturer II

**Duties:** Teaching; setting and invigilating term tests and final examinations; reporting final grades; counseling students; supervising teaching assistant(s).
