BIO150Y1Y: Organisms in Their Environment (100% FCE)

Course description: Evolutionary, ecological, and behavioural responses of organisms to their environment at the level of individuals, populations, communities, and ecosystems.

Estimate of the course enrolment: 144

Estimate of TA support: 0 hours for lectures (6 x 64 hours for laboratories)

Class Schedule: Lectures are Tuesdays and Thursdays, 10:00-12:00 noon, from May 11 to August 12; final exam period is August 16-20, 2010.

Sessional dates of appointment: May 1 to August 31, 2010.

Salary: \$13,390 for Sessional Lecturer I minimum salary; \$14,290 for Sessional Lecturer II minimum salary; \$14,990 for Sessional Lecturer III minimum salary inclusive of vacation pay.

Qualifications: Demonstrated excellence in teaching required. Ability, academic qualifications and suitability for this course, including advanced knowledge of evolutionary biology, behavioural and evolutionary ecology, population and community ecology, and global change ecology required. PhD degree required. Prior experience teaching this or a similar university-level course preferred.

A brief description of the duties: Preparation and delivery of lectures; conducting weekly help sessions; available for office hours; preparation, supervision, and grading of tests and examinations in accordance with University regulations as described in the Faculty of Arts & Science Academic Handbook.
