COURSE DESCRIPTION:

This course will introduce students to the rationale, methods, and interpretative strategies regarding neuropsychological assessment and diagnosis involving known or suspected acquired neurological disorders in adults. Emphasis will be placed on learning the strengths and weaknesses of the various psychometric procedures currently used for neurocognitive testing and the critical importance of integrating this information with neurological, neuroradiological, and related medical data.
