Description of course: The course introduces the basic ideas of Finance. The problems of Finance stem fundamentally from the existence of time and risk. Financial contracts, institutions and markets serve to overcome these problems for individual investors and companies. The course analyzes the nature and role of financial markets and instruments, including stocks, bonds and options, the valuation of financial instruments, and optimal financing decisions of companies. The lectures will rely largely on the material in Ross, Westerfield, Jaffe, and Roberts Corporate Finance, Fourth Canadian Edition, McGraw Hill Ryerson Limited, 2005 (henceforth Ross et. al.).

Estimated Number of Available Positions: 1

Position description: Invigilate midterm test and final exam; assist in marking midterm, 2 assignments, and final exam; hold office hour every week; tabulate and record marks.

Minimum qualifications: Graduate student in Finance or Economics who has completed upper-level undergraduate finance courses and graduate level finance courses, especially in corporate finance.
