Member Mobilizer – Resourcing the Rank & File: Ford Cuts Campaign

C.U.P.E. 3902's Mobilization Committee has put together a member-driven campaign with a three pronged focus: 1) Distributing mobilizing honoraria for those doing political and organizing work against cuts to public services by The Ford Government; 2) organizing C.U.P.E. 3902's presence at coalition events, such as attending days of action or other important demonstrations; 3) preparing "rally kits" for caucuses and stewards so that they can be better prepared to engage in Ford Fightback efforts.

Member Mobilizer: this position focuses on having meaningful, face-to-face conversations with members.

Tasks include:

- Going to members in their places of work, or other sites on campus, to start conversations about the Ford Government's policies and to build engagement in the campaign and the Local.
- Organizing member participation at rallies and other fightback events.
- Organizing "office hours" and events at the C.U.P.E. 3902 office for members (e.g. button making).
- The Member Mobilizer will also assist in the following ways:
 - Helping the Campaign Coordinator to assemble and distribute rally kits.
 - Developing talking points and materials for engaging members with the Communication Coordinator.
 - Assisting and liaising with MobComm regarding steward recruitment.
 - Working closely with the Staff Organizer and Mobilization Committee to achieve the above tasks.

Applicants for this role should be: friendly and approachable; able to develop a strategy for connecting with our members; motivated and self-driven in implementing that strategy.

Honorarium: Duties will occur for the duration of the term, beginning in August and running until the end of the fall term. For the completion of duties associated with the Member Mobilizer position, an honorarium of \$2000 will be given.

Please note that union-service positions are not remunerated on an hourly basis and instead are based on fulfilling the duties outlined.

C.U.P.E. 3902 prioritises equality of opportunity and values diversity on its committees and amongst its representatives.
